Face Covering Wearer Guide



This face covering is intended to cover your mouth and nose whilst allowing you to breathe comfortably and does not constitute Personal Protective Equipment ("PPE"). 
The UK Government has advised that additional Covid-19 measures should be taken by individuals as lockdown restrictions are eased. These include the wearing of a face covering in enclosed spaces where social distancing is not always possible.

If you wear one, you should still do the important things necessary to prevent the spread of the virus.

These include:



Washing your hands properly and often



Social distancing (keeping at least 2 metres away from other people)



Not touching your eyes, nose, or mouth if your hands are not clean

You may choose to wear a face covering:



When staying 2 metres apart from people is difficult - for example, in shops, public spaces or public transport



When in an enclosed space with other people



How to care for the face covering



Wash at 60°C with detergent



Do Not Bleach



Tumble Dry at Low Heat



Iron at Low Heat



Do Not Dry Clean

When to replace the face covering

You should replace your face covering when it:



No longer covers the nose and mouth



Has stretched out or has damaged ties or straps



Cannot stay on the face



Has holes or tears in the fabric
